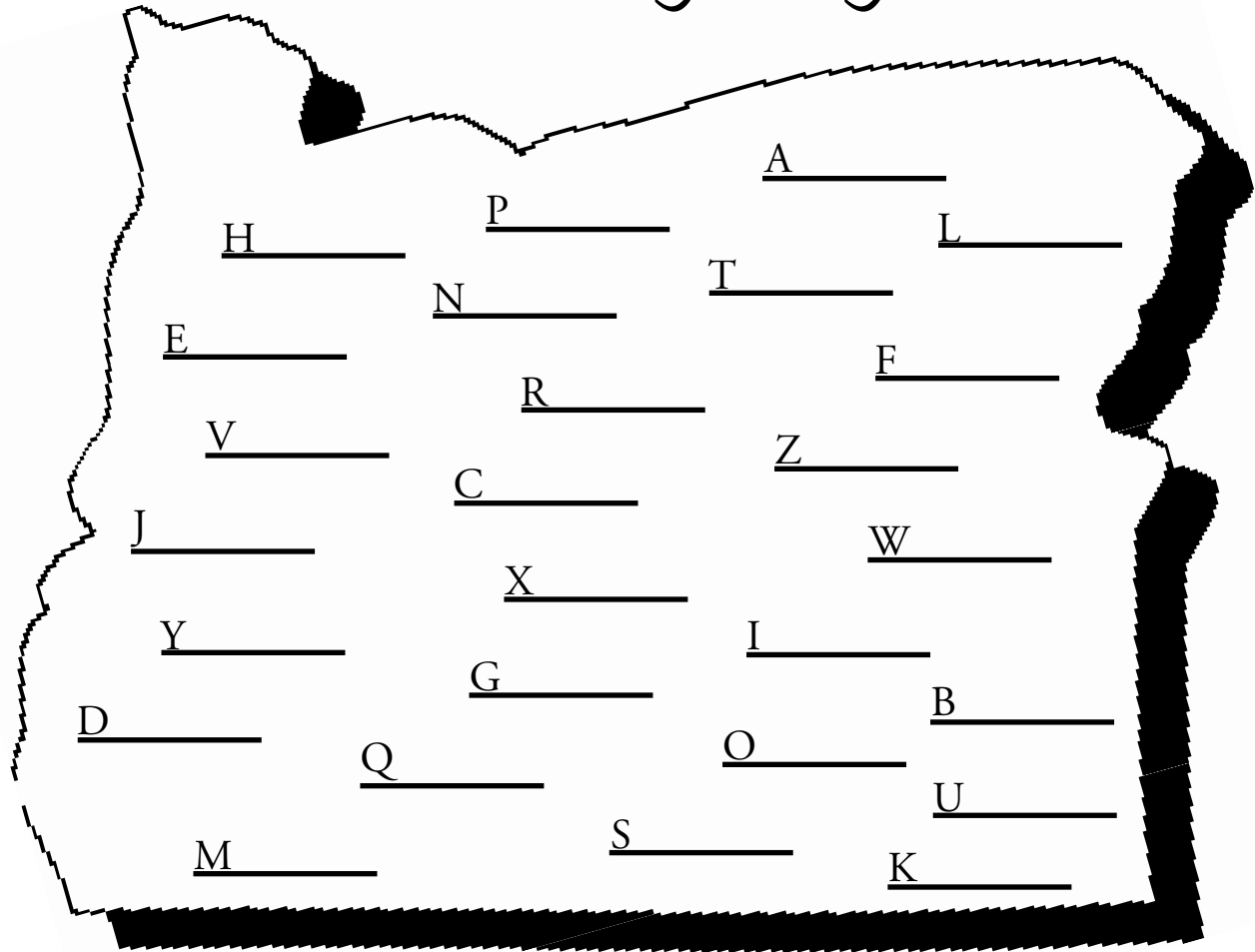


The ABC's of Oregon Agriculture



Diversity and quality are the words that best describe Oregon agriculture. With more than 225 commodities, Oregon ranks only behind California and Florida in the number of commodities produced. With so many different commodities produced in Oregon, there is at least one for every letter of the alphabet. Can you name them?

(There are several right answers for some letters.)

Encourage your students to be creative...think of prepared foods such as potatoes, french fries, mashed potatoes, baked potatoes, or specific types of flowers and trees.

For example, in Oregon A is for

Apples, Alfalfa, Asparagus, Artichokes, Apricots, Arborvitaes, Angus, and Alpacas.
