



AITC Calendar Contest Rules

Contest Purpose:

To create a positive learning experience for elementary students about agriculture in Oregon that furthers their understanding of agriculture's impact on our daily lives.

Contest Deadline:

- ◆ Entries due **MAY 15, 2010**.

Entry Details:

- ◆ The contest is open to public, private and home school students in grades K-6.
- ◆ **Students' art must be original.** Creativity and lots of color are encouraged.
- ◆ Artwork entered in the contest should feature **Oregon agriculture**. The calendar highlights the diversity of agriculture throughout the state.
- ◆ Art media can be markers, crayon, watercolor, ink, acrylic, tempera pain or colored pencil. **No pastel, chalk, pencil or 3-dimensional art.**
- ◆ **SIZE: Entries must be 11 by 8.5 inches, HORIZONTAL pictures only.**
- ◆ Entries must be on paper that will allow duplication, scanning and display. Entries must be flat. Do not fold, matte, mount, laminate or frame art. Use of cartoon characters or TV figures is not acceptable.
- ◆ An official entry blank or copy **MUST** be completed and securely taped to the back of each entry. Please do not staple forms to artwork. (Duplicate forms as needed.) Make sure each entry is filled out completely and that writing is legible.
- ◆ **EACH TEACHER MUST SUBMIT A SUMMARY SHEET WITH THE NAME (FIRST AND LAST) OF EACH STUDENT.** The summary sheet should include the school, address, phone number, grade, teacher's name and signature.

- ◆ **Mail entries to:** Agriculture in the Classroom, 305 Strand Ag Hall, Oregon State University, Corvallis, OR 97331.
- ◆ All entries will become the property of the Oregon Agriculture in the Classroom Foundation and will not be returned. Oregon Agriculture in the Classroom Foundation reserves the right to publish the entries in future publications without additional compensation, in any manner and at its sole discretion in all advertising materials.
